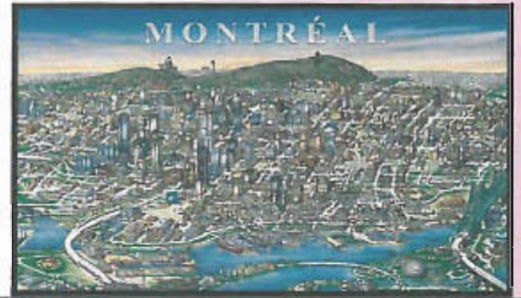

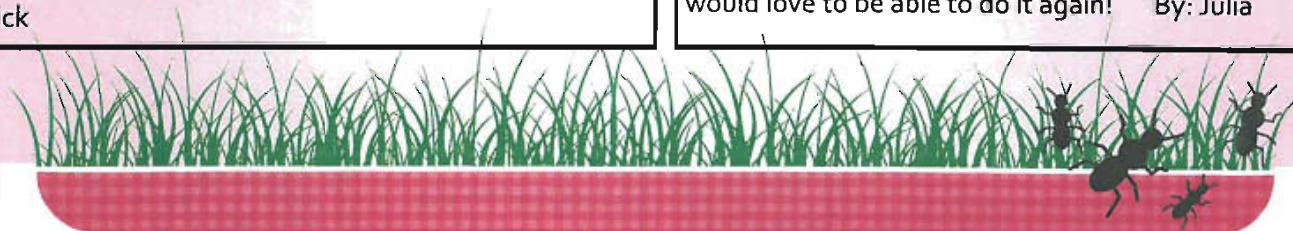
## It Was All Smiles Volunteering at the Rodeo of Smiles
